A look at the happenings (July – Sept. 2013)

1. 10 years Evaluation:

At the end of 10 years of existence, we tried to get a feedback from 3 of the pillars of Samavedana: Employees, volunteers and you – the Donors. The most important aspect that came forward was ‘lacking visibility’ and ‘participation of youth’.

This finding led us to formulate our ‘Marketing Plan 13-14’. Though the term Marketing is seen negatively for Social sector, we believe that in coming years, NGOs or VOs will be run as social businesses and will need to use all management concepts in running it.

2. Charity Partnership:



We are implementing a new idea for visibility. We proposed Corporate / business firms in various sectors to endorse us as their ‘Charity Partners’. With reference to a cardiology case referred by Dr. Avinash Pol, Social Activist from Satara, who got aid from Samavedana, Zilla Parishad of Satara have approached us for financial aid to around 50 cardiac patient children, studding in Satara ZP schools. We will be doing these cases along with Jeevan Dayee Yojana of State Government. We plan to raise fund for this project from Satara district only. *Those, who have any Satara connections, please give us the referrals for funding.*

6. Social Returns on your donations:

At the end, last but not the least, we have recently undergone training on measuring 'Social Returns on Investment' - which will give correct worth of returns on YOUR investments in the form of donations.

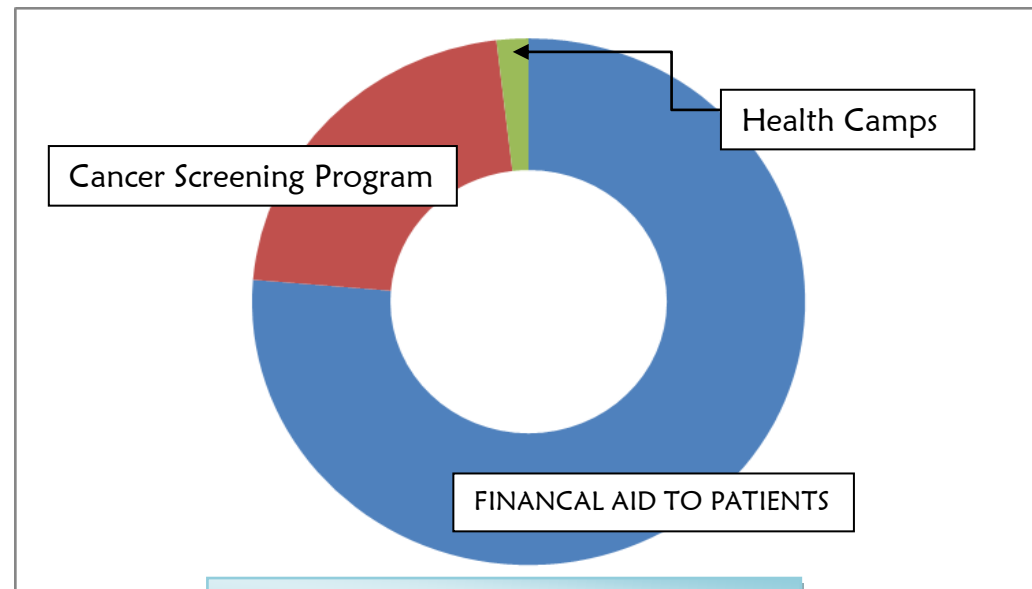

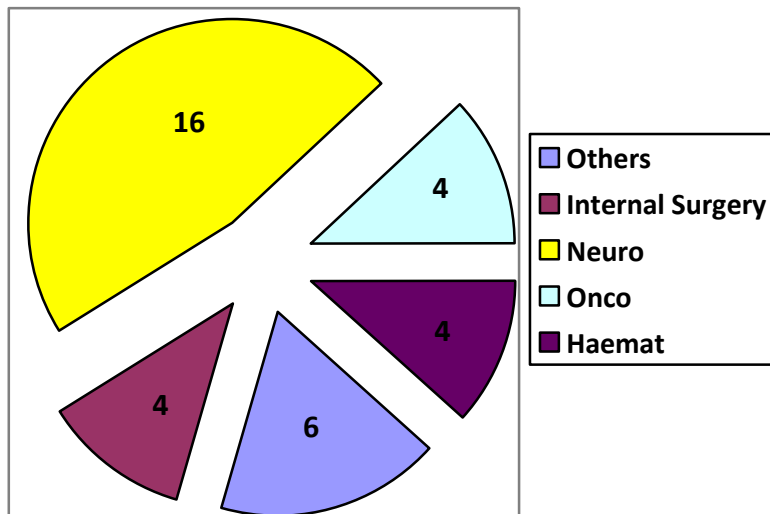

Patients Review:

This has been a busy quarter as we have done tremendous work, we could help as many as 40 patients. Sahyadri Hospital at Karve road became healing station to 80% of them by treating 32 patients of them. Kasba Peth, Nagar Road, Kothrud, Bopodi, Hadapsar and Swargate units of Sahyadri Hospitals did their bit by treating one each while Karad Hospital took care of 2 patients.



Patients Analysis: Specialty Wise

As the graph suggests, we treated 16 neurology/neurosurgery patients. The number of these patients has always been higher than the other specialties. We could help 4 patients needing treatment for Internal Surgery, hematology and oncology/oncosurgery specialties. While the rest of the patients (6) were required to undergo treatment in orthopedic, vascular and gynecology specialties.

A Case: Mr Laxman Sonne:

Laxman was referred to Samavedana by sister NGO – Vidarthi Sahayak Samiti, where Laxman's brother is staying.

He came to Samavedana complaining fever spikes on and off. Laxman, 26, worked as Machine Operator at a factory in Hyderabad, was operated for Arnold Chiari Malformation. Even after the operation he was observed to have persistent fever.

His family comes from draught affected Osmanabad district. His parents, who work as laborers in farms couldn't find any work to daily wages because of the draught, making Laxman the only earning member of the family. Laxman's brother pursues education under learn and earn program to complete his graduation.

Having already spent a lot of money for earlier operation, this poor family's financials were almost exhausted. This is when the patient came to Samavedana. Samavedana sanctioned the financial aid and with Sahyadri Hospital's and its doctors' contributions the Sonne family could take a breath of sigh as the pillar of their family was revived.

Out of total bill of Rs. 2.5 Lacs, Sonne family raised Rs. 40 thousand. Doctors waived off Rs. 54 thousand of their fees, the hospital gave concession of Rs. 21 thousand and Samavedana contributed Rs. 1.29 lacs through generous donation of around 25 donors.

We thank every donor and well wisher on behalf of Sonne family.
