## QUARTERLY REPORT

Dear all,

Last quarter of the year: quarter of completing the targets, quarter of donations and tax investments, quarter of planning of the annual function of Samavedana.

We could gather a sum of Rs. 44 Lacs in this quarter, thus annual donation collection of Rs. 1.04 Lacs. However, I must admit that we could not achieve the target of Rs. 1.15 Crore for FY 2013-14. Major setback was due the recession and general downstream in the market. By now, we have been able not to deny help to any patient on grounds of lack of funds. But, if we don't achieve the target this year, we will have to disappoint the patients, for whom Samavedana is the last ray of hope. However, I am sure, this day won't arise and we will score the high with your continued in order to suffice increasing need.

This quarter was of networking with different groups ranging from army officers to management students. Samavedana's funding model was appreciated by Narsi Monji Institute of Management Sciences, Mumbai and I was invited to deliver lecture on 'Fund raising Strategies and Techniques'. Department of Management Sciences, University of Pune invited to share the Samavedana experience and to deliver a lecture on 'Social Entrepreneurship' for retiring Army Officers. It was a very gratifying experience for us.

However, on the skin donation front, we were not very successful during this quarter. Though we had 3 awareness events, we could get only 2 skins in donation.

Lastly, we are planning the annual function, which is scheduled in last week of May 14. Communication in this regards and the invitation will be sent at appropriate times. We request at this juncture, to let us know, if you have any contacts of the organization who can sponsor the event / give advertisement in our annual report, which is going to be a souvenir containing brief review of 10 years plus annual review of FY 2013-14.

A look at the happenings (January to March 2014)

**January and February:** In three different events, Samavedana spread awareness among 150 women about organ and Skin donation. These events were organized by Tanishqa Groups. The events were noticed by Sakal daily in Pune edition.
