Inauguration of renovated Sahyadri Hospital at Nashik: Sahyadri Hospitals Nashik unit was inaugurated on 7th of April. As we all know Sahyadri is very closely associated with Samavedana. With the larger unit of Sahyadri in Nashik, we can now start treating Samavedana patients at Nashik also.

Only 22 women went through **Preventive Cancer Screening at Karad** during this quarter. We have covered women from current villages and 'Bastis' and now are in talks with several SHGs/NGOs to collaborate with to run this program continuously at Karad.

CII's workshop on 'CSR: Corporate and NGO perspective': With the new law about companies' spending on social activities already in the run, this workshop cleared many doubts and presented the true nature of the law. This will be helpful while we project ourselves to the corporate seeking associations.
