Retrospect

Dear all,

I am very happy to put this quarterly report before you and to announce that another of our pride programs, 'School health Program' started in this quarter. The quarter was completely charged up for starting of 'School Health Program (SHP)'. We commenced pilot stage of the program with 2 rural and an urban school. A brief report on the same is given in inside pages.

Another very important achievement of the quarter is approval by Maharashtra Foundation, USA. MF is funding intermediary from US, which was established decades ago, in order to help NGOs in Maharashtra for US citizens. Mr. Anand Deshpande, Chicago, representative of MF visited our clinic in October and then our proposal of funding the clinic for 1 year got approved. More important is approval by MF is like 'Credibility Certificate' in US and hence our funding from US will definitely go up in coming period.

Since 2013, due to new Companies Act, corporates have started donating / sponsoring social projects. In accordance with this, 2 major corporate entities – Potain India and KSB have associated with us. Potain has sanctioned us sponsorship for Cancer Screening of 300 women and KSB is donating us a fully equipped Mobile Medical Unit. We have been looking forward to bring essential healthcare within reach of Medically Deprived interior parts of Mulshi tehsil. This vehicle will help us in providing such healthcare to really poor population of this area, in association with Health Department of Pune Zilla Parishad. Very soon we will be entering a tri-partied agreement between KSB, District Health Officer, Pune and us.

With the newly started School Health Programme (SHP), we are acting in tune with our revised vision of bringing essential healthcare to the deprived. All 3 aspects of healthcare: Treatment, Prevention and Awareness are catered in the program aiming 'Every child passing 10th should be healthy and health aware'. In the pilot phase started on 22nd Nov. 16 till February 2017, we screened 2250 students. This process is a great learning experience for all of us.

During this period, we also conducted check up camp for children in age group of 0 to 6 years at our clinic. 168 children from the community got benefitted from it. A



child with major cardiac problem was referred to cardiologist, along with a few noticeable ailments, now under treatment.

I personally got an opportunity to be part of 'Retreat' with Shri. Nipunbhai Mehta, Founder <u>ServiceSpace.org</u>, a 3 day workshop, where heads of select NGOs were invited for participation. Retreat focused on 'Inner Transformation' while working in social sector for the delegates.

Overall the quarter was flooded with enthusiasm of starting new project and as we have decided, Samavedana was able to reach out to thousands of deprived houses, through its various programs.

We look forward to your valuable suggestions to forward this mission. You are most welcome to visit us at our office, clinic or during the outreach. Thanks for your active support and well wishes.

Important Events

<u>5th Oct</u>: Mr Anand Deshpande, representative of **Maharashtra Foundation**, NJ – USA, visited **Samavedana Clinic** at Upper Indiranagar to evaluate the project. A few days after his visit, MF approved request for **sponsorship** and will support Clinic for the year 2017.

<u>7th-8th Oct</u>: On the occasion of '*Daanutsav*', Indian Oil Corp. invited Samavedana to use IOC Pump's space at Karve Road to promote Samavedana activities. We thank IOCL and Daanutsav for this opportunity.

25th Oct : Potain India Pvt Ltd has sponsored the Preventive Cancer Screening Program run by Samavedana for the FY 2016-17.



<u>6th Nov</u>: Samavedana Clinic in association with Sahyadri Hospitals organized a free Cardiac Check Up Camp for community of Upper Indira Nagar. 38 people were benefitted from this camp.

<u>27th Nov</u>: We participated in **Upayn** – An event of different donations by Deepstambh Charitable Trust, where we presented Skin and Organ Donation. More than 100 individuals interacted with our representatives during the event.

In this quarter, we presented session on Skin and Organ Donation at the platforms like MKCL's Annual Event, PwC India and Bharati Vidyapeeth's Pharmacy College (Batch of Pharm D organized the event) to reach out to more than 500 individuals with the message of organ donation.

School Health Programmes' pilot activity was run in Rashtriya Sarvangin Vikas Santha's school in Asade (22 Nov) followed by Veer Baaji Pasalkar Vidyalaya in Panshet (28th and 29th Nov) . The pilot project's screening phase concluded with 4 day activity at Upper Indiranagar's complex of Shree Ram Rajya Sanstha (14th Dec to 17th Dec). First intervention included screening and primary examination of more





than 2000 students from rural and urban slum background. We have planned second intervention with curative aspect along with awareness and health promotion.

The kind of involvement and participation school bodies have shown is really commendable. Together, we believ, can better the future of future generation of

India.

12th to 17th Dec: Samavedana Clinic organized free general health check up camp for children aged between 0 to 6 yrs. 168 kids were screened for general ailments. One child was observed to have heart disease through this activity and this can be highlighted as success of Clinic. The child is going through treatment.
