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We stepped in 2018 with a challenge of proving Cancer Screening Programme and School health Programme are the right solutions for major health challenges women and children face. Cancer still being a taboo we needed to make some adjustments to the programme and develop a system that accelerates our input-output ratio. The partnerships with Public Health Department, Pune ZP and Pune Municipal Corporation worked like wonders. We have achieved 80% of our annual target with one quarter to go. Strengthening team has helped School Health Programme perform better and we are ahead of the schedule. We can, now having covered physical, eye examination, learning disability assessment and health education sessions, work on curative measures as well as building capabilities through converting education into action.

State Government has come up with some beautiful schemes for serving the underprivileged section needing healthcare. Implementation of *Jeevandaayee Yojana* & *Ayushman Bharat* are two of the milestones in the journey for financially challenged patients. These are the schemes that make NGOs like Samavedana's job easier by taking the load off. Also the scale at which government can offer services cannot be matched and

we are happy for their initiatives.

Samavedana has also entered an implied partnership with Maharashtra Government CMRF Patient Assistance Cell by supporting Rotary International initiated *Mission Muskaan*. The mission works towards curing infants, toddlers and children bound with life threatening diseases. Samavedana contributes a share to secure healthy future of the nation at Sahyadri Hospital Nagar Road, Pune. Aware through outreach activities conducted by Mission Prerana and Samavedana, non-affording parents from all across come seeking free treatment for their offspring.

It's the end of 2018 and it was indeed a positive year for Samavedana. With School Health Programme and Cancer Screening Programme performing to their best, the team worked really hard for the quality of the programmes and got the best numbers so far. We are also rewarded with *Guidestar India Gold Transparency Certificate* as well as are awarded with *Annual Nelda Recognition 2018* and *Pune NGOs Leadership Award*.

Notingly, the quarter also leaves a shatter in the heart of the team as we had to shut down Samavedana Community Clinic in Upper Indiranagar permanently because it didn't return good results even after trying relentlessly for 3 years. The bright side, however, is the need of the community, which at the first place triggered Samavedana to start the clinic there, is being satisfied by

satellite clinics by fellow NGOs and PMC clinic in the community. We take back all the learnings and experience this project gave us. We will continue to be the bridge by providing essential care needed by the society.

We also take huge pride to have partnered with Bharat Forge for implementing one of their CSR Projects in 5 blocks in Maharashtra. The association has shown favourable developments and potential for improving health status of the women at the at-risk age-group of having cancer.

We are set to continue the solid run at serving the beneficiaries in the coming quarter with focus being women and children. Amidst all the pleasing outset, there lies a worry of satisfying funding needs for the year 2018-19, especially for the School Health and FinAid programme (for children's surgeries). The quarter will see CSR and individuals contributing more but we are projected toward facing a deficit of Rs 40 lacs at the end of this financial year. We will carry through this path with generous helping hands like you and end 2018-19 on a even brighter note. We will keep you posted through our social platforms.




Expenses This Quarter: ₹ 30,03,995 Expenses Last Quarter: ₹ 40,12,726
