We are very happy to present before you the report of first quarter of FY 2018-19 before you. The quarter as usual, was very important, as lot many things happened during these 3 months. We celebrated our 15th Annual Day on 29th April. We were fortunate to have senior psychiatrist and actor Dr Mohan Agashe to watch 'Astu' and have a dialogue on the same, with Dr Charudutt Apte. 15th Annual Report was also published at the hands of Dr Agashe. The event attracted huge response from the audience.

15 years! A time period of one and half decade is over, and in this period we reached from 26 beneficiaries to 10000 plus. Time really flies.

On 11th May, we enjoyed handover ceremony of the mammography machine and Tata Winger vehicle for commutation of women for cancer screening program, donated by Rotary Club of Poona, one of the Pune's oldest rotary club. The machine is installed at Sahyadri Hospital, Hadapsar. We will soon start 2nd phase of cancer screening program at Sahyadri Hospital, Hadapsar. The donation is worth Rs. 37 Lacs of rupees. We take this opportunity to thank Mr Kailash Monga, convener of the programme and the entire team at Rotary Club of Poona.

In conjunction with this development, we are geared up to reach out to larger communities, including those from rural Pune. Our Cancer screening program is approved by Pune Zilla Parishad, for use of VIA for cancer of cervix and iBeastExam for breast cancer. We will be covering Mulshi and Khed blocks of Pune district. We started by organizing 4 camps at PHCs in Khed block in the month of May and June covering 217 women. Similarly, we will soon be starting our program at 5 PMC run hospitals. We experienced openness of mind from a partner NGO this quarter. Samavedana is starting fellowship from this year. Praja - an NGO working in governance at Delhi and Mumbai shared all their wisdom and experience for starting this. This helped us a lot while developing formats and structures. We thank Praja and its CEO Mr Milind Mhaske & team from bottom of the heart. For achieving any success, team work is very important. We had a small team building outing on 14th of June . We spent 3 hours together, at the serene campus of FLAME University, Lawale. The time was well utilized to know each other, through a game called 'Guess Your Mate'!

Lastly, Samavedana received 2 accolades during the quarter! After stringent check and due diligence, GuideStarIndia, has granted us a 'GuideStarIndia Gold' certification for transparency for 2018 in May 2018 and Nelda Foundation awarded us with 'Nelda Recognition 2018' on 24th June 2018. Such honors make us happy, but also make us more sensitive towards the responsibility on the shoulders, assigned by the donors with full trust.




11th May: Rotary Club of Poona and RI has donated a Mammography machine for screening cancer in women. They have also donated a van for commutation of beneficiaries from their slum communities and village to Sahyadri Hospital, Hadapsar, where the machine is installed. This donation will enable us to scale up our Preventive Cancer Screening activity and reach a larger beneficiary base in South of Pune.



May - June: In association with Rotary Club of Nigdi and Bridgestone India introduced our Community Based Cancer Screening Programme Khed to Rajgurunagar tehsil. The Public Health system of Khed supported us in conducting such screening camps in Wada, Pimpalgaon, Shel Khed and Dehane. Total of 217 women were screened during this activity.
