Samavedana is increasing with leaps and bounds. Focusing more on cancer screening and children health through School Health Program and Little Hearts program, it is ready to engage in the next gear.

We were working on various fronts simultaneously for last 2 quarters viz.:

1. Technological up-gradation to support:
 - a. Ensuring larger reach through digital media
 - b. Facilitating for online / electronic donations
 - c. Maintaining meaningful, coherent data
2. Creating an environment enabling the scaling of each program
3. Creating an environment for harmonizing larger teams and achieving need - resource balance
4. Finding sources and ways for raising funds to suffice the needs arising of scaling.

In last quarter, we entered partnerships with different organizations to realize above mentioned goals. For facilitating online donations, we hired services of 'DanaMojo'- a payment gateway platform dedicated to NGO sector. This will also help us accept foreign contributions directly from the source through website. We also engaged 'Catalon' & 'Indi Designs' to upgrade our digital presence through re-vamped website and use of social media. For more efficient data handling, we are availing services of 'GoKarma' – a solution developed for NGOs. 'Leap2excel' helped us in streamlining HR processes and competency mapping. We're glad to mention that most of these services are availed at NO or LOW price.

Of course all these things, though had taken front seat in last quarter, the 'basics' – our programs also achieved all the targets. Cancer screening program was very successful – by screening 4000+ women in the year, (as against the target of 3000) and 4051 women during the quarter. In the month of February 19 alone, we screened 935 women. There were challenges in convincing women to undergo higher investigations, which are worked upon and showing positive results. Thanks to Desai Brothers Ltd. and Kalyani - Bharat Forge for sponsoring the cancer screening program.

School Health Program finished hospital based eye check-ups of 157 children which is 58% of found to have some defect in vision. 15 children also got operated for various defects like squint, ptosis, cataract etc.

To add to our pride and gratification, recently started 'Little Hearts' project has got huge response. By complimenting GoM's 'Mission Muksan' to support surgeries of children born with a disease or defect, we helped 70 children with congenital heart defect to give them new lease of life. Thanks to Desai Brothers Ltd., Persistent Foundation & Miba Drivetech Pvt. Ltd. for their contribution in bringing lovely smiles on little faces.

At the end of the year, we are very thankful to each and every supporter, YOU, for contributing to this noble cause of bringing essential healthcare to the underprivileged. Looking at the receipts and expenditures, year 18-19, we spent around Rs. 1.70 Cr. on various projects, which were just raised through various sources, mostly through individual donors and a few of corporate partners. We are so thankful to each and every one for their kind contribution to make it possible to reach out to 14000+ direct beneficiaries.

Way ahead: In the year 2019-20, we are looking further for adding 4 more blocks from 2 more districts to Cancer Screening program with the help of Bharat Forge. We were expecting this year to be concluding year for School Health Program in Mulshi block, making it a 'model' to be replicated, but we now expect the program to be extended by another year. We will keep you updated on the same. Under Little Hearts Program, we look forward to help 400 children with various diseases like cardiac defects, liver problems, blood disorders or neurological diseases. This is going to double our budget, increasing from Rs. 2.5 Cr. to Rs. 5 Cr or more. We bank on your sure support to reach out to, the target ,of 16000 lives in 2019-20.

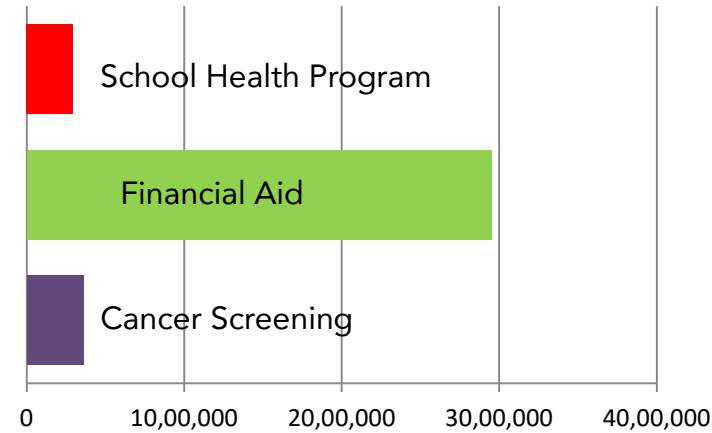
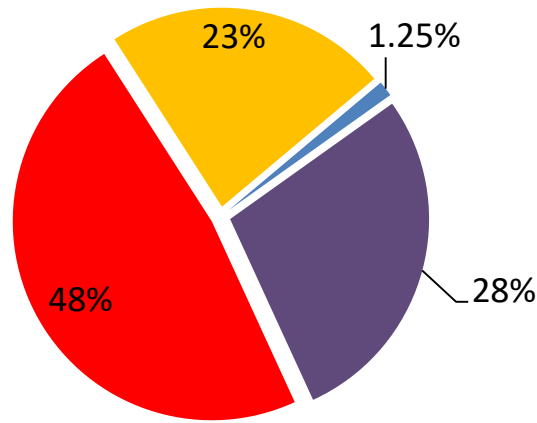

Program-wise Beneficiaries and Expenses

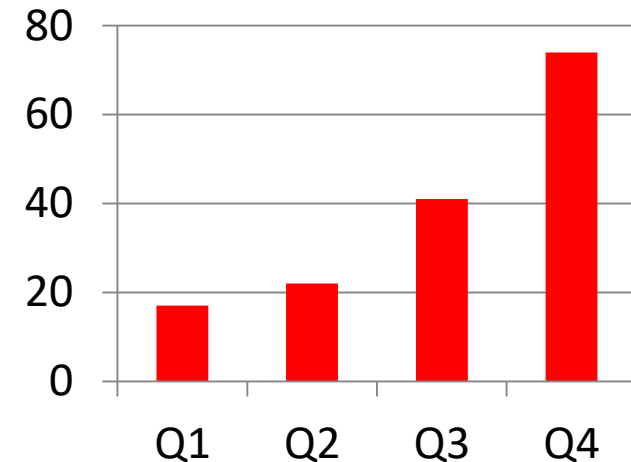
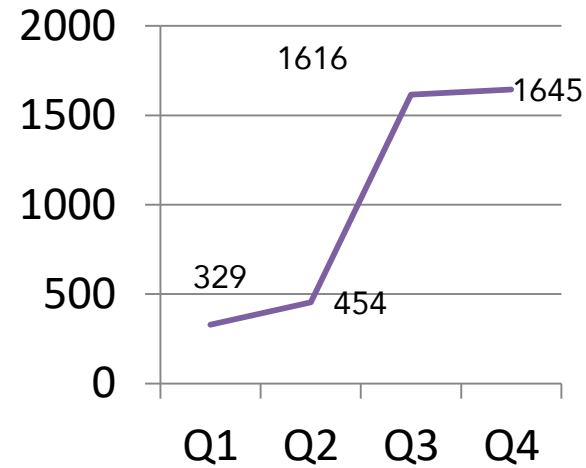
